### **SNOW POLICY**

### **Sunny Hill Preschool will be closed for a snow day when the Sudbury Public Schools are closed for a snow day.**

Please watch your local TV news stations or listen to WBZ 1030 radio station for updates on Sudbury Public School closings. If in doubt, the Sunny Hill message machine will carry a cancellation notice if school is closed for the day.

- **Sunny Hill will be closed for a snow day when the Sudbury Public Schools are closed for a snow day.**
- **If the Sudbury Public Schools have a one-hour delay--Sunny Hill will have a one-hour delay.** AM sessions and Stay and Play will begin at 10 AM.
- **If the Sudbury Public Schools have a two-hour delay--Sunny Hill will cancel all morning sessions.** Afternoon Stay & Play will begin at 11:30. The 9-1 class will open from 11:30 until 1:00. Afternoon sessions will begin as usual at 12:30.
- **If the Sudbury Public Schools cancel morning kindergarten--Sunny Hill will cancel all morning sessions. If afternoon kindergarten is held:** The 9-1 class will open from 11:30 until 1:00. Afternoon Stay & Play will begin at 11:30. Afternoon sessions will begin as usual at 12:30.
- **If the Sudbury Public Schools cancel afternoon kindergarten--Sunny Hill will cancel all afternoon sessions.** Sunny Hill will cancel the afternoon session and the 9-1:00 class will close at 11:30. Morning Stay & Play will close at 11:30 as well. **We ask that all families return to pick up their children at 11:30 that day.**

If Sunny Hill should be closed due to weather conditions or for any other reason when the Sudbury Public Schools are open, we will make every effort to notify parents as early as possible by phone.

We do not make these days up at the end of the year.

**Please note however:** Whenever Sunny Hill is open on an inclement day, as a parent you are urged to always use your own discretion when making a decision to attend school in inclement weather. If you ever feel the weather is not safe to send your child to school, you should always make the decision to keep your child home from school that day.
